## Confronting a roadmap in the fight against Capitalism – Imperialism

In order to speak - write about this topic, of course we have to go back a long way from the very appearance of Imperialism, the symbolic cruel beginning in the hike of Capitalism and Imperialism which belongs to the distant 1492 when the famous Columbus, making the wrong way to India, found himself on the coast of The Caribbean Islands. With the discovery of the two American continents, the campaign of subjugation by exploiting natural resources begins, setting a roadmap for a global redistribution of wealth from the stronger to the weaker, until today, and this method has continued on other continents as well. Unfortunately, a simple recipe, with which the European capitalist countries could not help but use it for their own appetites through their filthy methods, and to begin with, they exterminated the native population (for example, America, where we have an unheard of genocide, and where only until today it is considered that around 54 million native people have been executed).

After this genocidal procedure, ruthless robbery was carried out - exploitation of the common goods, i.e. all the wealth of the land, the soil, the minerals, the living world, in order to continue to draw the imperialist border of the stolen countries-continents, and to finally introduce their rule of law.

. Such methods, developed to perfection, continue in the following centuries, until today. The globalist world view of things is through the rule of law with laws, with a monopoly on the use of force, to preserve wealth in the hands of a few families and individuals. After this initial phase, it passes into a mature phase of Capitalism, which is filled with state institutional exploitative robberies - industrial enslavement, and in the future to pass into a phase of imperialist wars in which the big actors try to divide the spoils among themselves.

The first imperial wars were started by the French Empire under the leadership of Napoleon Bonaparte in the second half of the 19th century, and the same continuing to line up through the participation of Great Britain, and more recently from the 20th century, the United States, Germany, etc. But for the sake of the common working man, the villager, in all this misfortune, free-minded minds are appearing in the world who do not look at this kind of Imperialist view and doctrine

with good intentions, but on the contrary, on their own initiative, at the beginning, they express the opposite attitude towards Imperialism, and later, by grouping, massively stand on the side of the class struggle of Proletarian Internationalism against Capitalism – Imperialism – Imperialist wars.

The first pioneers in this war against Imperialism appeared during the French Revolution to continue later as the bearers of this war, Rosa Luxemburg, Karl Liebknecht and later Lenin.

Imperialism as the world domination of the stronger over the weaker, more precisely colonial domination of economic, cultural and territorial relations, represents the greatest evil of the proletarian world. Of course, it must be noted here that the United States is considered the main carrier of Imperialism, but the fact that the entire Western capitalist bloc is in league with the United States, must not be left out. As a conclusion of all this, the Libyan, Syrian, and Iraqi wars should be taken as an example, where the main role was played by the United States, and the British, French and other armies played a secondary role in this operation.

Imperialism is considered the highest stage of Capitalism, so we see every day how from hour to hour, day to day, year to year, it increases its influence throughout the world through the so-called "Peaceful democratic way", and those countries that will oppose and resist, will be defeated militarily as so-called "undemocratic regimes".

But imperialism must not be unilaterally accepted as a historical phenomenon from the point of view that there have been wars before, but these wars, these subjugations are precisely determined from the point of view of economic domination, i.e. exploitation by the imperialist powers through the use of energy, mineral wealth, cheap labor, etc. Also, we must not consider these to have happened by chance. Even a hundred years ago, the mentioned Rosa Luxemburg, Karl Liebknecht, Lenin, the English liberal John Hopson spoke about such complex phenomena in the book Imperialism 1902. Such analysts complemented Marx's teaching because in the 19th century industrialization was at a lower stage, more precisely at that time small and medium-sized companies that competed at the local level dominated. However, Marx also predicted that a time would come for "concentration and centralization of capital", which is true, and was also confirmed already at the beginning of the 20th century by his students, mentioned in the text.

With the accumulation of capital, large corporations are created that centralize the entire flow of capital, for as long as we can remember in our country, we used to go to neighborhood stores for ordinary daily needs, but now it's different, trade is concentrated in large trade chains, so small colonials are closed and people lose their jobs. The total economic flows are concentrated through the big concerts and they are increasing more and more, but also in the other direction, the same capital is concentrated in a smaller and smaller number of heavy billionaire capitalists. Everything that imperialism applied through its mechanisms for and around world domination, it also applied after the collapse of the socialist bloc in Europe and the Balkans. Since the beginning of the 90s of the last century, world imperialism, through various domestic counter-revolutionaries, managed to overthrow the socialist states, turning them into "liberal" economies. The "good positive imperialists" dismantled the socialist system and created a mechanism for global exploitation, both of financial, raw material and intellectual goods. Unofficial data about the depletion of goods from the disintegrated Socialist-European bloc together with Russia in a period of 20 years reaches a staggering 10-15,000 billion by the imperialist financial and industrial trusts. Almost all state-owned banks on the soil of Eastern Europe passed overnight into the ownership of foreign capitalists, and all this through the false doctrine that by passing to private property and liberal monetarism, finance and the economy will experience such growth that the peoples of the post-socialist countries will be overjoyed. But instead of the false promise that was given that average salaries will be around one thousand euros, pensions around seven hundred euros, that the number of new jobs will increase, the opposite happened on the soil of Eastern Europe. Millions of people were left on the streets, and not to mention the pensioners, they barely survive each day. But in addition to economic dependence, the countries of South-Eastern Europe also became militarily-politically dependent and not having the opportunity to develop their own defense forces, imperialism dragged them into military alliances - pacts (such as the NATO pact). Through the mechanisms for the same logistical arming and purchase of these dependent countries (arming from the capitalist market) there was a complete pumping out of the financial goods, which were already negative. To be secure and under control, imperialist interests installed NATO bases in individual regions of Europe and the world, thereby gaining overall control in the regions i.e. the countries of the Eastern bloc. In order to make sure of any dissatisfaction, Western imperialism, through the installed mechanisms

(such as International Courts, etc.) exerts pressure, i.e. suspends any possibility of expressing any dissatisfaction. Having in their hands the world's largest information resources, they are marketing unprecedented propaganda, false deceptions, falsifications of truths, etc.

This kind of imperialism also used its biggest joker in conquering world domination, which is the so-called social - democratic. "left", using it as a modern European "left" to soften proletarian labor protests and movements. These same social democrats use individual entry into the ranks of the communist parties to soften the sharpness of the class antagonism between monopoly capital and the worker in certain times of crisis. They also put the trade union leaders in the loop, so they act through them in the area of mitigating their reactions, i.e. through empty verbalism as if they were supposedly on the worker's side.

I believe that the image of imperialism and its global influence is given, but I also believe that this imperialism and capitalism have no solution for a good individual economic growth of the worker, and here, with the appearance of the World Economic Crisis, the beginning of the end of capitalism is seen.

Therefore, what is most needed now is the unification of the original left-oriented actors of the world trend, which of course are the communist and worker's parties, as well as the movements in conjunction with the overthrow of capitalist imperialism. All communist and workers' parties, should selflessly help each other at every moment and in every sense, in order to increase the pressure for the final fall of imperialism, i.e. capitalism. All of us, communist and workers' parties, should as soon as possible bring a platform for concrete measures in the fight against imperialism, from which platform will arise appropriate road signs, so that every actor can help in this fight against the world evil - Imperialism. I believe that all of us communists and workers, from all over the world, must be optimistic about this unequal struggle and unite our ranks as never, in order to deliver the final blow to capitalism, i.e. globalism, specifically imperialism.
