

Statement of the Forces of the Syrian Interior

We, the forces within the Syrian national interior, representing a number of its national parties, civil society organizations, and influential national figures in the ongoing Syrian events, issue the following statement:

First: Regarding the extensive Israeli aggression against Syrian territory and its occupation of various areas and destruction of the capabilities of the Syrian army, we condemn this aggression, which we consider an imminent danger. We also condemn at the same time the internal and external silence of some public forces towards this Israeli aggression.

Second: Concerning the political solution in Syria, we demand the implementation of UN Security Council Resolution 2254 in accordance with what has been imposed by the new reality that necessitates involving all national forces within Syria—national parties, civil society organizations, and influential and active figures.

Third: We call upon Arab countries that are keen on Syria's unity—both land and people—to confront Israeli aggression in southern Syria by all means possible, including sending Arab forces to prevent this occupation.

Fourth: The statements made by Mr. Ahmad al-Shara (Head of Military Operations) affirming:

- The unity of Syrian territory
- The preservation of state institutions
- That Syria is a non-sectarian state
- The prohibition of sectarian incitement
- The sanctity of Syrian blood

And calling for a cessation of fighting across all Syrian territory while maintaining security and civil peace and preserving freedoms necessitate practical implementation through clear and announced steps to alleviate fears and

concerns among the people due to certain violations and practices in various areas that contradict this declared discourse.
